

Marc Humbert, MD, PhD, is Professor of Respiratory Medicine at the South Paris University in Le Kremlin-Bicêtre, France. In addition to his academic responsibilities, he is the Director of the National Reference Centre for Pulmonary Hypertension, Department of Respiratory and Intensive Care Medicine, Hospital Bicetre, Assistance Publique Hôpitaux de Paris, France. Along with membership to several scientific councils and institutes, Marc Humbert is the past Chairman of the Research Committee of the Assistance Publique Hôpitaux de Paris and current Director of the INSERM Unit "Pulmonary Hypertension: Pathophysiology and Innovative Therapies" and of the "Thorax Innovation" University Hospital Department. Since January 2013, he is the Chief Editor of the European Respiratory Journal. He has published widely in asthma, pulmonary hypertension and pulmonary inflammation in the most prestigious medical journals and has received several distinctions including the Cournand Lecture Award from the European Respiratory Society (2006), the Descartes-Huygens Award from the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences (2009) and the Fondation EGP Rare Disease Award, Fondation des Maladies Rares (2016).
