Francesco Bonella is Assistant Professor at the Unit for Interstitial and Rare Lung Disease, Department of Pneumology of the Ruhrlandklinik University Hospital in Essen, Germany. After receiving his MD and Board Certification at the University of Verona, Italy, he earned his international PhD in Interstitial Lung Diseases at the University of Essen under the guidance of Professor Ulrich Costabel. Dr Bonella's research interests include IPF, alveolar proteinosis, rheumatic-associated ILDs, and sarcoidosis with a special focus on biomarkers, genetic predisposition and applications of bronchoalveolar lavage. In recent years, he has acted as an investigator for major clinical trials in IPF, sarcoidosis and alveolar proteinosis. He is reviewer for numerous scientific journals and has authored many chapters in textbooks, original articles, case reports, editorials and reviews. He co-founded EuPAPNet, the European Network for Alveolar Proteinosis, and was coordinator of the ILD core network inside the European Reference Network (ERN)-Lung. He is a member of several scientific societies, and is Chair elected of the ERS Rare DPLD group.
