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He received his medical degree magna cum laude at the Padua University. After completing Hematology, Allergology and Internal Medicine residencies he joined the Medicine Department (DIMED), reading Allergology and Clinical Immunology for medical students at the School of Medicine. With a background in clinical immunology he has had a longstanding interest in immune mediated interstitial lung diseases and in the development of new therapies for immune disorders. Primary and secondary immunodeficiencies, bone marrow derived precursors during chronic and inflammatory diseases, and lymphoproliferative disorders have been of central scientific interest for him.

He was a member of several Executive Committees, including WASOG, and the Chairman of the *Primary Immunodeficiencies* IG of the EAACI (2015-2017). During the last two decades he was member of the Editorial Boards in several International Journals
