2. Rare ("orphan") pulmonary diseases, including lymphangioleiomyomatosis, eosinophilic pulmonary diseases (idiopathic chronic and acute eosinophilic pneumonias, Churg-Strauss syndrome), Wegener' granulomatosis, hereditary hemorrhagic telangiectasia, histiocytosis X, etc.
3. Idiopathic interstitial pneumonias, especially idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis, nonspecific interstitial pneumonia, and organizing pneumonia.
4. Pulmonary hypertension associated with chronic respiratory diseases: combined pulmonary fibrosis and emphysema, idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis, lymphangioleiomyomatosis


