

Theodoros Kontakiotis is currently Professor of Pneumology, Head of the Pulmonary Department, Medical School, Faculty of Health, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece. He also supervises the Lung Cancer, Bronchoscopy and Sleep Disorders Units of the Pulmonary Department.

He was born in Athens in 1955, obtained his Diploma of Medical School in 1979 and his Doctoral Thesis in 1990, both at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. He was certified as “Pulmonary Medicine Specialist” in 1987. He had a Full Registration In General Medical Council – London, UK (1988-1989) for postgraduate work in lung cancer at the Wythenshawe University Hospital of Manchester, and at the Rotherham Hospital UK, and for a postgraduate work on respiratory physiology in the experimental laboratory at the Royal Hallamshire Hospital, Sheffield UK.

His clinical work and research focuses on epidemiology, diagnosis and treatment of lung cancer, on diagnostic and interventional bronchoscopy, BAL, paediatric bronchoscopy and medical thoracoscopy. Another field of professional activities is respiratory function in sleep disorders. He participated in official research projects and in clinical trials. He is a reviewer of international journals and has co-authored over 100 papers and book chapters. Furthermore, he is a member of PhDs’ and MSs Reading Committees and he has been concerned with several educational assignments.
