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She has been a practicing pulmonologist in a tertiary hospital for the past 20 years. She has spent 6 months at Charing Cross Hospital as part of her specialization and six months at the University of Colorado Medical Center and National Jewish Hospital specializing in interstitial lung diseases. She runs, with her team, a busy ILD outpatient clinic with computerized patient records and HRCT's, participates in Greece's IPF registries and has started a pulmonary rehabilitation program for ILD patients in her Department.
