

Dr. Lower is Professor of Medicine at the University of Cincinnati. After completing undergraduate training at Baylor University, she received her medical degree from the University of Cincinnati. She joined the Internal Medicine staff at the University of Cincinnati after completing both an Internal Medicine residency and fellowship training in Hematology/Oncology at the University of Cincinnati. Her major research interests include breast cancer management and the treatment of sarcoidosis. Along with her long time collaborator Dr. Robert Baughman, she has developed several novel treatments for sarcoidosis, including methotrexate, thalidomide, leflunomide, and infliximab. She has published over 120 peer reviewed articles and reviews, including 86 regarding sarcoidosis. Current studies include treatments for sarcoidosis associated fatigue and onconeural antibodies in sarcoidosis.
