

Wim Wuyts is Associate Professor at the University of Leuven, Belgium, where he is the driving force behind the interstitial lung disease programme at the Laboratory of Respiratory Medicine. He is also responsible for the ILD Unit in the Department of Respiratory Medicine at the University Hospitals Leuven. Professor Wuyts obtained his medical degree and completed his postgraduate training in respiratory medicine at the University of Leuven. He obtained a PhD in respiratory medicine at the KU Leuven. He specialised further at the interstitial lung disease unit of the Department of pulmonary medicine at the Royal Brompton Hospital, London, UK. Professor Wuyts' research interests include chronic inflammation and fibrosis in chronic progressive fibrosing lung diseases such as IPF, chronic hypersensitivity pneumonitis and ILD secondary to connective tissue diseases. He is the author of scientific publications in peer-reviewed journals concerning ILDs, lung transplantation, pulmonary hypertension and asthma.
